5. Financial Report for 2011

6. Program of work of the assembly in 2012.

This timetable was designed for the presentation of the work program of the assembly in 2012. Prof. Trajkovski explained that during the 2012 MSSA plans to perform several activities:

- Detection of new cases of autism;
- Proposed new autism projects;
- Running in joint projects with Macedonian platform to combat poverty, CIRA and others;
- Celebration of International Day of Persons with Autism April 2;
- Intensification of cooperation with the local government;
- Organizing educational seminar on a specific method in the treatment of autism with the financial support of the Austrian Embassy in the Republic. Macedonia;
- Invitation distinguished lecturer from the U.S. or the EU to speak about autism;
- Selected several master works associated with autism by members of MSSA;
- Publication of at least one paper on autism in foreign journals;
- Activities for establishment of a national register for autism.

After presenting the program, Zivka Panova Sazdova give a proposal for the formation of mini teams that will work on several areas: education projects, seminars and symposium. MSSA

President accepted the proposal and urged audience members to engage on this issue. After this vote adopted the work program MSSA 2012.

7. Autism and comorbidity-Prof. Dr. Mary Raleva

Seventh item on the agenda was designed for lecture by prof. Dr. Mary Raleva on "Autism and comorbidity." Following the lecture open discussion in which word taken prof. Dr. Dragoslav Kopachev, prof. Dr. Nada Pop-Jordanova and Dr. Mary Boskovski.

8. Various

The last point Various, Mr. Vladimir Ilievski said it has visited training on how you can apply projects of civic associations. Zivka Dimitrovska comment on the absence of Center for Autism and Prof. Trajkovski address that MSSA still will strive to support the idea of opening a Center for Autism. Zivka Panova Sazdova noted that there are shortcomings in the school program for children with autism. Mr. Trshanska give an explanation that says that programs should be the same for all. Mr. Ilievski give a proposal to make the forum will be attended by the Minister of Education, BDE, UNICEF, government and NGOs, the WHO Office. This activity could be done on 2nd April on the occasion of World Autism Day.

After exhaustion of the items of the agenda, prof. Dr. Vladimir Trajkovski thanked the attendees for their participation of Annual Meeting and wished them a happy and successful 2012.
